

Hello WNSS students & families,

As the end of the semester approaches, we wanted to provide you with more information about our Final Culminating Activity (FCA) days.

- Teachers have created course summative assessments which are being worked on in classes by students in June during the final weeks of the semester.
- In addition, for most courses, there will also be a Final Culminating Activity (FCA) that must be completed in person on a designated FCA day. This could be an exam, performance, portfolio presentation, or other task.
- Teachers have shared the final culminating activity expectations with students well in advance.
- Teachers will send a reminder students and families by June 8th to identify the expectations for each course during the FCA dates on June 17-23.
- For courses without a mandatory FCA task during those scheduled dates, some students will be expected to attend because more demonstration of learning is required for successful course completion. Teachers will communicate with students and guardians by Monday, June 15th, when attendance is required.
- For courses without a formal FCA task students can attend in-person on the Final Culminating Activity Day for course improvement in consultation with their teacher.

June 8	Teachers will email students & families about the FCA expectations for all courses
June 15	Teachers will communicate with students & families IF the student is expected to attend on a non-mandatory FCA date because more demonstration of learning is required for course completion
June 16	Teacher and students consult about attendance for improvement during the FCA dates for courses without a mandatory FCA
June 17	Period 1 Final Culminating Activity – starts at 8:05 am
June 18	Period 2 Final Culminating Activity – starts at 8:05 am
June 19	Period 3 Final Culminating Activity – starts at 8:05 am
June 22	Period 4 Final Culminating Activity – starts at 8:05 am
June 23	Period 5 Final Culminating Activity – starts at 8:05 am

- All final culminating activities will begin promptly at 8:05 a.m.
- The bus schedule remains the same, so please arrange for transportation home after your final culminating activity task is complete.
- Students who remain at school will be required to stay in the supervised library until 2:10 p.m. dismissal.
- There is no cafeteria service during this time.
