2) National Day of Truth and Reconciliation/Orange Shirt Day

- a) The National Day of Truth and Reconciliation and Orange Shirt Day, September 30, is quickly approaching.

The National Day for Truth and Reconciliation became a federally observed day on July 20, 2021, to be observed on September 30th each year. Sharing this day with Orange Shirt Day, a day widely recognized across the country since 2013. This day provides an opportunity for Canadians to recognize and commemorate the legacy of Residential Schools. On Friday, September 30th, students and staff across the DSBN will wear Orange to recognize the harm that the Residential School System had on First Nations, Métis and Inuit children and to recognize that, "Every Child Matters."
