Test Yourself:

A great way to assess how Flashcards are a proven tool much you've learned is to create a quiz for yourself.

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Write out a set of questions or sentences with blanks where the hardest things for you to remember are. After waiting for 30 minutes, return to the quiz and try to fill in the blanks. This delayed recall helps strengthen memory and shows you what areas still need work. By writing your own questions, you actively engage with the material, which reinforces learning more than passive review.
