WHAT HAPPENS WHEN YOU ARRIVE

Step 2: Go downstairs (lower level) and find your name on the wall in the Players Hallway (*teachers will come around to deliver medals before the ceremony).

Step 3: STAY AT YOUR NAME! (*it is warm and crowded in this hallway FYI)

Step 4: Remove name from wall and keep safe (you will need this later in the ceremony).

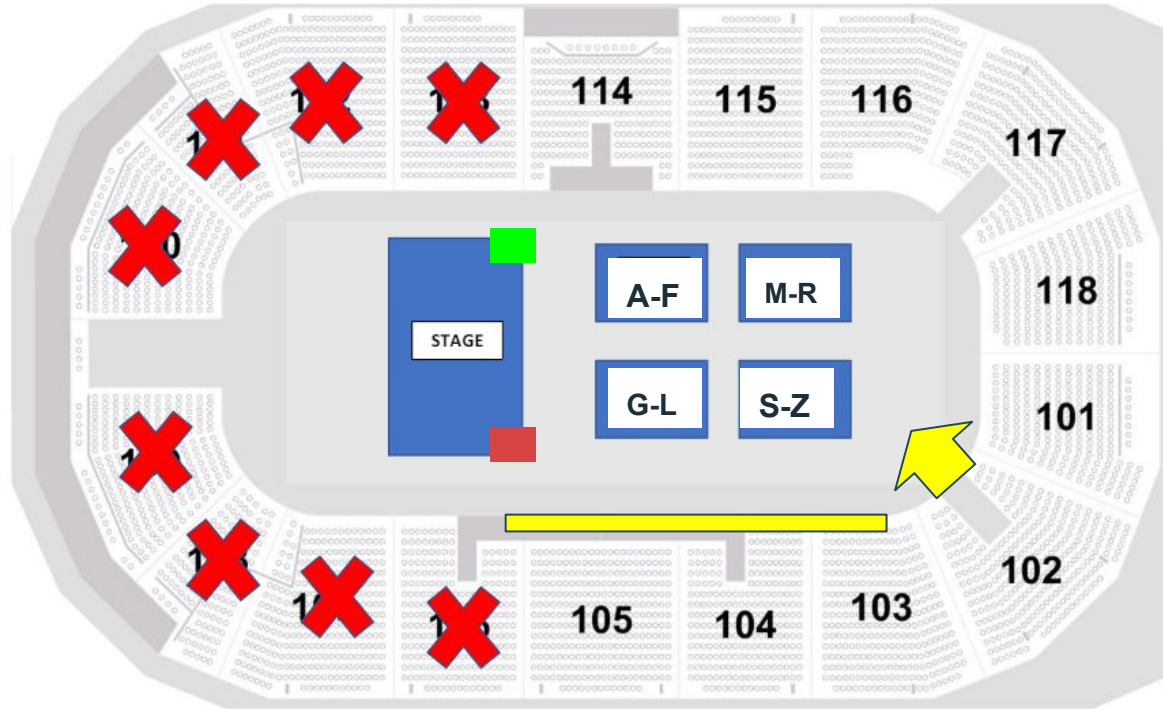

X- no seating

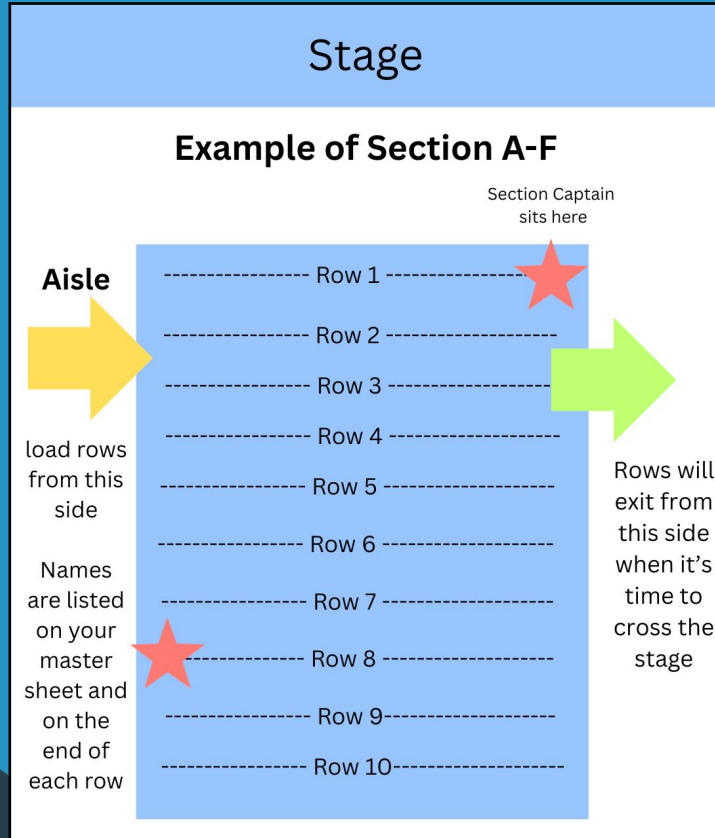
Arrow- Grads

4. Community Donor Awards
5. Presentation of Diplomas, Certificates, and Awards
6. Valedictorian Address
7. Closing Remarks
8. Tossing of the Caps (*no recessional)

THE PROPER WAY TO WEAR YOUR



Short side at the
front

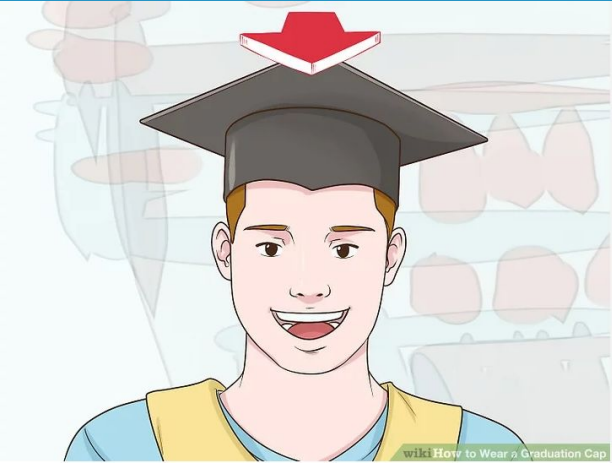


Long side at the
back

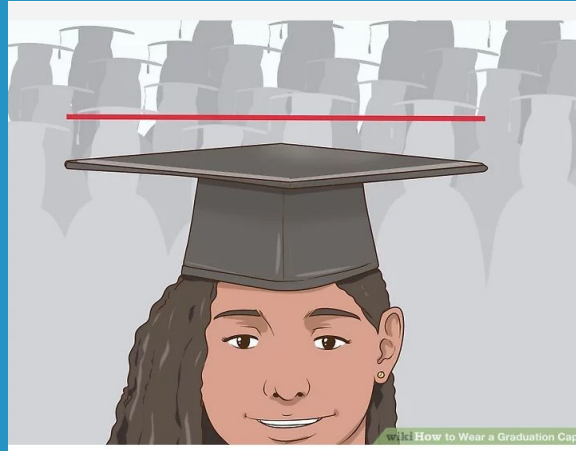
Just like a mullet....



THE PROPER WAY TO WEAR YOUR CAP



Arrange the cap so that the point is at the front



Make sure the cap sits evenly



The tassel should sit on the right side of your cap at the beginning of the ceremony, and moved to the left side once the ceremony is over.

RECEIVING YOUR DIPLOMA

1. When it is your section's turn, your section captain will lead you to the stage.
2. Hand your slip of paper with your name on it (from the wall in the Players Hallway), to Mr. Weber.
3. When your name is called, go up on stage and receive your diploma. Shake hands with right, receive diploma left.
4. SMILE at the camera **NOT** at the Jumbotron.
5. Once you cross the stage, find the diploma table to exchange your fake diploma with your real one.
6. Find Miss. Mokrzynski who will direct you back to your seat.



DIPLOMA FOLDER- WHAT'S INSIDE

1. Actual Diploma
2. Transcript
3. Letter from Government
4. Ontario Scholar Certificate (if applicable)
5. Tech/Business/French Certificate (if applicable)
6. SHSM Record (if applicable)
7. Class Composite (if purchased)
8. Awards (if applicable...if you receive an award make sure to send a thank you card to the donor)



AWARDS



Option 1: Donor Call Up

- Some awards are given by the donor who is in attendance and recipients will be called up to receive the award (this is separate from you walking the stage to get your diploma).

Option 2: Award in diploma folder

- Some awards will be given during your general statement when you go and receive your diploma. They can be found in your diploma folder. Don't forget your THANK YOU CARD.


