Wolfpack and Families,

I have a few reminders and information items for you.

- 1) I wanted to clarify some details around our **cafeteria**, based on some parent questions
  - a) Although we <u>do</u> have the ability to seat <u>more</u> students than at either of our previous schools, the cafeteria does not seat all students
  - b) The cafeteria has three sections surrounding the cafeteria kitchen
  - Secondary school cafeterias are not designed to seat all students this includes schools with a variety of restaurants in walkable distance (e.g. Grimsby SS, Beamsville SS), and schools that do not have many nearby restaurants (e.g. E.L. Crossley, Greater Fort Erie)
  - d) Secondary students often choose to eat in other locations such as the library, classrooms, or in other seating areas through the building some also leave campus at lunch time for a variety of reasons
  - e) Soon, there will be a variety of activities, intramurals, meetings etc. that students will be participating in at lunch
  - f) The cafeteria is open for students to sit and eat in, and has been since our first day
  - g) The student run cafeteria servery has not opened yet due to some reasons related to commissioning the kitchen, and training our students to run lunch service this does take some time
  - Students are encouraged to bring their own lunch we have also provided some other food for purchase through the food trucks and school cafe (starting tomorrow)
  - i) If your child is struggling with lunch hour where to eat, getting lunch etc., please reach out and we can help. The building is new and we are all learning.
