## 2) Specialist High Skills Major Programs (SHSM)

- a) WNSS offers ten Specialist High Skills Major programs in the following areas:
  - i) Health and Wellness
  - ii) Sport
  - iii) Manufacturing
  - iv) Construction
  - v) Information and Communications Technology
  - vi) Hospitality and Tourism
  - vii) Food Processing
  - viii) The Arts
  - ix) Horticulture and Landscaping
  - x) Agriculture
- b) A SHSM program is aimed at grade 11 and 12 students and consists of some targeted courses to the area, a coop work experience, and some specialized training sessions offered to students at no cost (e.g. First Aid/CPR, safe food handling for Hospitality and Food Processing etc.)
- c) Students who meet program requirements earn a red seal on their Secondary School Diploma, which can lead to program, employment, and scholarship opportunities at post secondary institutions
- d) These are excellent programs and opportunities for students in grades 11 and 12

# **Knowledgehook-Free**

- b) Knowledgehook is an online platform that makes learning fun via challenges linked to the Grade 9 math curriculum. Teachers can use Knowledgehook to enhance the learning of students both in the classroom and at home by offering tailored 'challenges' via the platform based on each student's individual strengths and needs. In addition, students can use Knowledgehook for self-directed learning to expand their understanding and scope of mathematical concepts.
- c) All students enrolled in Grade 9 MTH 1W mathematics have access to Knowledgehook via their D2L accounts. Students will receive on-boarding to the platform this month through their mathematics teacher.
- d) We encourage you to explore both of these platforms with your student at home. To build self-efficacy and transferable skills, a strategy would be to remind and direct your students to these platforms.
