Wolfpack and Families,

Two information items for you as we head into the weekend:

1) Final Culminating Activity (FCA) days - formerly known as exam days

As usual, the final evaluation for each class will match the instruction and evaluation throughout the semester for that class. In some cases, this will be a written exam, and in some cases this will be a performance task, project, or other means of evaluation.

Next week, each family will hear from each of your child's teachers. They will be communicating around the final evaluation for their course. They will let you know what the final evaluation for the course is composed of (exam, project, performance, a combination of things, etc.) and when it will occur. If the class has a final evaluation that occurs before the FCA days, the teacher will communicate if your child needs to attend on the scheduled FCA day, or not.

Please note:

- -transportation runs on a regular schedule on these days students need to arrange their own transportation if they wish to head home earlier
- -students do not attend on their MSIP day
- -if there are any instances of inclement weather, we will communicate out the corresponding change in schedule

Please expect communication from each of your child's teachers by the end of next week.

2) Food service next week

For next week, there will be some alterations to our cafeteria service heading into the winter break.

Monday-Wednesday - service as usual Thursday - cold food only Friday - cafeteria closed at lunch to clean up/prepare for the break
