1) Dental Screening

a) Has your teen seen a dentist in the last year? Do you have dental insurance? Students 17 years old and under may be eligible to receive free dental services.

A registered dental hygienist from Public Health will be visiting our school to offer students 17 and under free dental screening.

The registered dental hygienist will take a quick look at your child's teeth using a sterilized dental mirror. Dental screenings can help identify urgent dental issues and link eligible students to Healthy Smiles Ontario.
