 - ii) Wednesday, April 9 for students with last names M–Z
- b) This sitting of the test is for students in grade 10 who were not successful in the Fall sitting, and for previously eligible students (grade 11 or 12) students who are attempting the test again
- c) By Friday, March 7, students will receive an email to their DSBN student accounts with their test location and details on any accommodations.
- d) Extra test prep is available during MSIP periods and at lunch on Tuesdays and Thursdays in Room 235.
