5) An Important Message from Niagara Region Public Health

Please make sure your child's immunization record or exemption information is up-to-date with Public Health

This school year, Public Health will be doing its <u>annual review of student immunization</u> <u>records</u>. You will only receive an immunization reminder notice if Public Health has incomplete vaccination information on file for your child.

How to confirm your child's vaccination information is complete:

Review and update your child's immunization record on Immunization Connect (ICON)

- Make sure all the vaccinations they have received are listed. If some are missing, add them.
- Check the Immunizations Needed section. If you child is missing vaccine(s), get them vaccinated. Once received, add them to your child's immunization record in ICON. Health care providers do not do this for you.

If you previously submitted an <u>exemption</u>, make sure you followed the process for school aged children. Child care exemption forms expire when your child enters school in September.
