I have two important information items for you:

1) **Late Activity Bus**

Late activity buses start running today, September 6th.

All students that wish to ride the late bus **MUST** register for the bus prior to boarding. This will allow office/board staff to monitor bus usage and keep the required daily passenger manifest. This can be done on the Late Bus App on any connected device (same location as D2L and Aspen). We have included a QR Code this year, which makes it even easier for students to access the late bus app. The QR code will also be available on the bus for students as well. Are you interested in representing your school's student body? Are you someone who works well with others, communicates effectively, and wants to develop their leadership skills? If your answers are yes, keep reading to learn more about how you could become a member of DSBN's Student Trustee Senate Committee.

What is a Student Senator?

Student Trustee Senate is a committee of the Board that meets once a month throughout the school year (note: transportation is provided when meetings are in-person). These meetings give an opportunity for the Senators to act as an advisory body to the three Student Trustees who chair the meetings. The Senators (two per secondary school) provide a perspective on student issues and communicate with their school's student body about the decisions made by DSBN. Being involved in the Student Trustee Senate Committee also provides leadership opportunities for Senators as they advocate and learn the purpose and work of DSBN.

Do I have to be on Student Council to be in Student Trustee Senate?

Although you do not have to be in Student Council, senators should be reporting back to their schools. This can be done through the Senate Teacher Advisor and/or Student Council.
