Summer Registration Packages & September Updates

This is done ONLINE. All registration items are emailed home mid-August to the primary guardian email provided. Be sure to check your inbox for this important information during the last weeks of August. STEP 2: Payment of Student Activity Fees using School Cash Online

Student Activity Fees can be completed on-line using the SCHOOL CASH ONLINE feature, a secure and reliable link that is available on our website at https://westniagara.dsbn.org/home.

Prevalent Medical Conditions: Plan of Care

A Plan of Care specific to the student needs is required for all students with a prevalent medical condition. Anaphylaxis, asthma, diabetes, or epilepsy require a Plan of Care specific to their prevalent medical health condition. Other life-threatening medical conditions require a Plan of Care – General. A Plan of Care document outlines a student's specific health needs and steps necessary to support their well-being in the school environment.
